"Recycling mandate eliminated in budget" - JSOnline

Gov. Scott Walker's two-year budget would take the unprecedented step of eliminating a state requirement that communities operate recycling programs. The Governor's proposed 2011-2013 Budget states:

"Eliminate the requirement that a municipality or county operate a recycling program to manage solid waste in compliance with the disposal restrictions, and eliminate the financial assistance for local government recycling programs. "

And

"Convert the recycling and renewable energy fund to the economic development fund. Transfer a portion of the recycling tipping fee and current appropriations that are for purposes related to the environment to the environmental fund. "

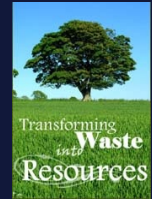
